7.2 Report Umpires Panel – Neil Smillie

• Emailed to all Clubs and Delegates 14th November 2017

"I have had a number of phone calls about the BOWLS Eye, (appearing on a Gippsland green!). The Bowls Eye is a perspex object with concentric circles etched into it to be used as pre-measure only. It cannot be used to determine shots.



Our State Umpiring Committee does not recommend its use, but it has been approved by World Bowls therefore cannot be prohibited. It is not particularly accurate, its a bit like crossed fingers... A memo from BA was sent to all CCOs and DUCs last year in July.

I have provided you all with a link to the BA memos, which apply to us all. This is good resource to have.

The memo specifically related to the Bowls Eye is July 2016 – Clarification to law 23.3. It may be a good time to send to your umpires as a refresher."

2. The Conditions of Play for BV Championships was delayed in getting approval and as a result of Clubs starting their championships it was decided not to publish 2017-18 version, thus Clubs, Regions and BV championships will be conducted under the 2016-17 COPs

3. I did mention that some material from previous RFC / COP that did not relate to Pennant / Championships would be place on BV website under Club Assist but it appears as yet BV have not uploaded this information. Again use that information from 2016-17 version until it is uploaded to the website.

4. In the last update I referred to a number of changes to the 2017-18 COPs but I was unaware of the following, please take note and these are to be applied for this season

(a) the finishing time on Saturdays for an interupted match is now 6.00pm not 6.30pm

(b) In the 19 Instantaneous Penalties 19.1 was removed due to differences to BA policy. As a result the penalties for 16. Smoking , 17. Personal Devices and 18. Consumption of Alcohol are now more severe than previously. The first offence is no longer a warning, it now carries an 8 shot penalty for Pennant

Instantaneous Penalties.. The first part about giving a warning was removed from the Instantaneous Penalties but for Player Behaviour, Smoking, Alcohol and Mobile phone an Umpire CAN apply the Instantaneous Penalty but the Umpire may opt to give a warning as CAN is optional.

7.3 Coaching - Lyn Goodchild

A questionnaire "analysis of Club resourses" i.e Umpires and Coaches will shortly be sent to all Sandbelt Clubs

This may help in the future running and development of Coaching courses for the Sandbelt Region. Introduction to Coaching course is designed specifically for Barefoot bowling and school children The Introduction to Coaching course conducted at Mulgrave Country Club on 1st December resulted in qualifying 16 new coaches.
